BON CHEF, DOUBLE-WALL BOWL

With Bon Chef's Angled Dual-Position Stainless Steel Double-Wall Bowl, the name says it all. The bases of these bowls are designed to sit flat or to tilt at an angle for a jauntier display. The bowls are made of stainless steel with a bright, mirror-finish exterior and interior. The bowls' insulating double-wall construction uses an inner pocket of air to keep food cold longer while preventing condensation from forming on the bowl exterior.



BON CHEF, BON STEEL TUSCANY FLATWARE

Bon Chef developed the Bon Steel Tuscany Pattern Flatware line as an antidote to rising nickel prices. The low- and no-nickel flatware serves as a lower-cost alternative to traditional 18/8 or 18/10 options—yet it looks and feels the same. (The knives, however, are made of the standard stainless formula for strength). And just like the traditional flatware, Bon Steel works perfectly well with trashcan magnet catchers that prevent flatware from being accidentally tossed.



BON CHEF, STRAIGHT-SIDED BOWL

The Straight-Sided Square and Rectangular Serving Bowl collection by Bon Chef is a geometry teacher's dream. Since their dimensions are all based on multiples of 5" and 7", the bowls fit together in many configurations, making them perfect for side-by-side presentations with zero wasted space in between. The white, 3"-high bowls are made of unbreakable aluminum and coated with a fired-on glaze especially designed for cold and ice.
